### *from the Principal .....*

Congratulations to Mrs Moore & Mr Goldsmith and the members of the **band** who represented Caboolture East State School at Fanfare. Their performance was outstanding and they were awarded a Bronze Medal. Great work and a fabulous effort by our band students.

The **last half hour of the day** is an important time for students and teachers. If you arrive early and are waiting to collect your child, please ensure you are not waiting directly outside your child's classroom. When students see their parents waiting they become distracted and are missing important information.

We are currently experiencing a peak period of infestation of **head lice**. I would ask all parents to please check their child's hair and treat if necessary. I would also advise you use preventative treatments to minimise the risk of your child contracting head lice. If everyone is vigilant we can help to control outbreaks and the spreading of head lice. Encourage your child to avoid head to head contact and the sharing of hats whilst at school.

We have been emailing monthly statements home highlighting the **outstanding invoices** on your child's account. These are emailed out at the end of the month. Please ensure that you have been receiving these, if not please contact the office to update your email address.

As you are aware, students and teachers this year have been working with the Australian Curriculum, as interpreted through Queensland's C2C curriculum resources. For the Semester One **report cards**, teachers are evaluating student work based on our school based C2C units and assessments tasks from Term 1 and 2 in most Key Learning Areas. Please note that in the Report Card an overall mark is given for achievement and an overall mark is given for effort. Each Key Learning Area will also have a comment from the classroom teacher. The report cards will be printed and ready for distribution mid next week.

Jenny is already very well known to our Year 1 students and the Year 1 teachers, so we are confident it will be a smooth transition for everyone.

We will also say farewell to Sandy Butler, Prep M's teacher aide. She will be leaving our school next term, for the rest of the year. Sandy and her family are relocating to another area and we wish them all the very best. Mrs Natalie Watson, one of our current teacher aides, will be taking on the role of teacher aide for Prep M for the rest of this year. Nat is already very well known to our students and teachers, so we are confident it will be a smooth transition for everyone.

Additionally Ms Jenny Latham, Year 6L teacher has been offered an 'Early Years Literacy' contract beginning in Term 3 at Caboolture East State School. This means that Jenny will conclude her Year 6L class at the end of Term 2 and begin her new role from the beginning of Term 3. I am sure you would join us in thanking Jenny for the dedicated contribution she has made to Caboolture East State School and the Year 6 students during Semester One this year. I am pleased to inform you that Mrs Mary Thompson, will be taking on the role of 6L teacher for the rest of this year. Mary is already very well known to our students and the Year 6 teachers, so we are confident it will be a smooth transition for everyone. Linked with this transition is a small movement of classrooms. Mr Shawn Osborne's class (6S) will be swapping classroom spaces with the existing (6L) classroom. This will occur at the end of term for the purposes of assisting Mary with transitioning the class.

This of course means that Ms Franciszka Iaone (Miss I for short) will continue to teach the 4T class for the rest of this year. The Year 4 teachers already plan cooperatively, share work programs, ideas and communicate regularly to ensure that teaching and learning in their classrooms meets the essential requirements of our school curriculum. Finally, there will also be some teacher fraction and staff changes in the Year 5 classes for the rest of this year. As from Term 3, 2016:

Each year we like to remind parents of the importance of your child having a hat. Childhood and adolescence are critical periods during which sun exposure is likely to contribute to skin cancer later in life.
