Caboolture East State School will receive

\$421,502*

This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of Prep - Year 6 (P-6) students achieving a 'C' or above in English by 10% from 2018 to 2019
- Increase the number of students meeting or exceeding the National Minimum Standard for Reading, Writing and Numeracy
- Increase number of students operating in NAPLAN Upper 2 Bands in Year 3 and Year 5 Reading and Numeracy to 20%
- Close the gap between the percentage of Indigenous and non-Indigenous students receiving a C or better in English by the end of Year 2, by improving outcomes for Indigenous students

Our initiatives include

- Developing teacher knowledge and understanding of the P-10 Australian Curriculum achievement standards by designing and supporting processes for robust intra-school and inter-school moderation
- Building capability and school wide consistency in Reading and Writing, utilising the expertise of a school-based Head of Learning through student success criteria and feedback
- Learning Teams utilising data to review, inform and monitor planning, moderation and explicit teaching to differentiate strategies to meet student needs
- Continuing to implement a whole school approach to teaching reading and writing
- Developing a plan for monitoring early phase literacy and numeracy, including the schedule of Early Start assessments, opportunities for professional conversations regarding student progress and strategies for intervention
- Providing professional development through modelling, coaching, peer observations and feedback for teachers and teacher aides.
- Supporting students' social emotional learning and wellbeing to increase positive behaviour and engagement in learning

Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| • Providing additional Speech Language Pathology for an extra 1.5 days/week | \$ 31 000 |
| • Supporting Literacy and Numeracy intervention by employing support staff: Head of Department-Learning and Learning Support Teacher | \$168 000 |
| • Employing para professionals to support reading and oral language intervention in P-6 | \$180 000 |
| • Investing in staff professional learning to support learning and wellbeing through the Berry St Education Model | \$ 22 000 |
| • Providing collaborative professional learning time to analyse data and inform targeted teaching | \$ 20 502 |
