Enhance learning outcomes in **Writing** and targeted instruction as outlined in our Annual School Priorities.

- At least 74% of students in all year levels will achieve a 'C' standard or above in English by the end of Semester Two.
- Every student will make one year's progress in English with a focus on Writing.
- 100% of teachers will be supported in classrooms by instructional coaches (knowledgeable others).
- Build success for all students in their early years of education including school transitions.
- Ensure high levels of student engagement in learning, through social emotional and wellbeing interventions which meet student needs.
- Build teachers' data literacy skills.

Our initiatives include


- An ongoing focus on connecting **Reading to improve Writing**.
- Support for teachers to implement a consistent, evidence-based approach to teach Writing.
- Investigate and develop pedagogies for engagement through the gradual release of responsibility and acceptance, and trauma informed practices in reading and writing.
- Analyse student pre-moderation and progress data to inform targeted teaching for individual students and evaluate the impact of teaching. In Learning Teams, teachers will use collaborative inquiry processes to identify problems of practice and implement improvement strategies.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- **Improve student achievement in writing and reading:** Providing human and physical resources to support Learning Teams to collaborate to deliver quality curriculum and pedagogy, targeted teaching and moderation practices eg teacher aides for guided reading/writing and intervention, administration support for data processes to monitor learning progress - \$121 000
- Employing para professionals to support reading/writing intervention in Prep – Year 6 - \$121 000
- Providing additional Speech Language Pathology for an extra one day/week – \$21 000
- **Professional Learning for Staff** – to develop high performing team practices and targeted instruction through teacher release for year level teams to collaborate with school leaders and Head of Learning (Sharratt & Hochman) – \$18 000
- Continue implementing the school **HERO Program** to proactively develop student wellbeing, self-regulation and learning engagement including playgroup - School Chaplain 0.2 FTE; HERO Teacher Aide; Berry Street Education Model Professional Development - \$61 791
- Increasing engagement and learning opportunities through the use of **Information and Communication Technologies** – ICT support, iPads, online learning programs - \$20 000
